


2011 CAJ Strengths, Parents

September 9-16, 2011, CAJ parents representing 322 families were asked to complete a google survey in which they were asked to respond to the following question: "Parents, what is 1 thing you like about CAJ?" Parents were then asked to identify which category the identified strength fit with. (The categories were user-friendly versions of CAJ's ends and focus groups).

Parents provided 76 submissions. The submissions were reviewed in terms of appropriate alignment of identified strengths and categories (which was not always a straightforward task, as some submissions may have addressed more than 1 category). As necessary, identified strengths were re-categorized. The chart below provides a breakdown of the categorization of the 66 submissions:



Here are the parent submissions, categorized by user-friendly versions of CAJ's ends and focus groups:

CAJ's student objectives:

1. CAJ provides an education based on Christianity and is an excellent school. There are quite a few mission schools in Japan, but most of these mission schools are Christian in name only.
2. The Word of God is the focal point, not just one of the subjects.
3. CAJ makes a declaration that Jesus is the center of the school.
4. That the Bible is not just a subject, but the guide for everything that takes place at CAJ. (Just ONE thing?...))
5. CAJ is the best place for my child to be educated as the curriculum and the environment of school has built up my kid's Christian character. This is very blessed education community that we cannot find from other schools.
6. We like your school philosophy, vision, program, and culture/atmosphere.
